SCARECROW COMPETITION

We would like to create an interest in the next generation about where their food comes from and how to keep it safe while growing. The 'Reuse, Recycle, Regeneration' Theme involves recovery from natural events that can affect food production such as droughts, fire, floods, and cyclones. The aim of the Regeneration Scarecrow Competition is to involve children in aspects of farming and to encourage their interest in the concept of growing their own edible plants and keeping those plants safe from hungry birds.

The competition will be judged, and certificates and rosettes will be awarded to First, Second and Third places. Major prize is a worm farm valued at \$500 for the one winning school.

- Open to Primary Schools, Day Care centres, NFP within Western Australia.
- · Free to enter.
- Restricted to one (1) entry per group.

COMPETITION RULES

- 1. Each school is required to provide one (1) scarecrow and it must be movable.
- Scarecrows and any props must be made from sustainable and recycled materials.
- Scarecrows must be freestanding with a size
 not exceeding 1.5m in height or 1m in width.
 All scarecrows to have a secure tag with scarecrows name
 on the front, group and a contact number on the back.
- 4. Scarecrows must be delivered on Friday 5th May 2023 between 10am and 4pm. Delivery location is Serpentine Horse and Pony Club grounds. Exhibits must be collected on Monday 8th May 2023 between 9am and 12pm unless pre-arranged with the Competition Coordinator. Uncollected exhibits will be disposed of.


JUDGING AND RESULTS
