

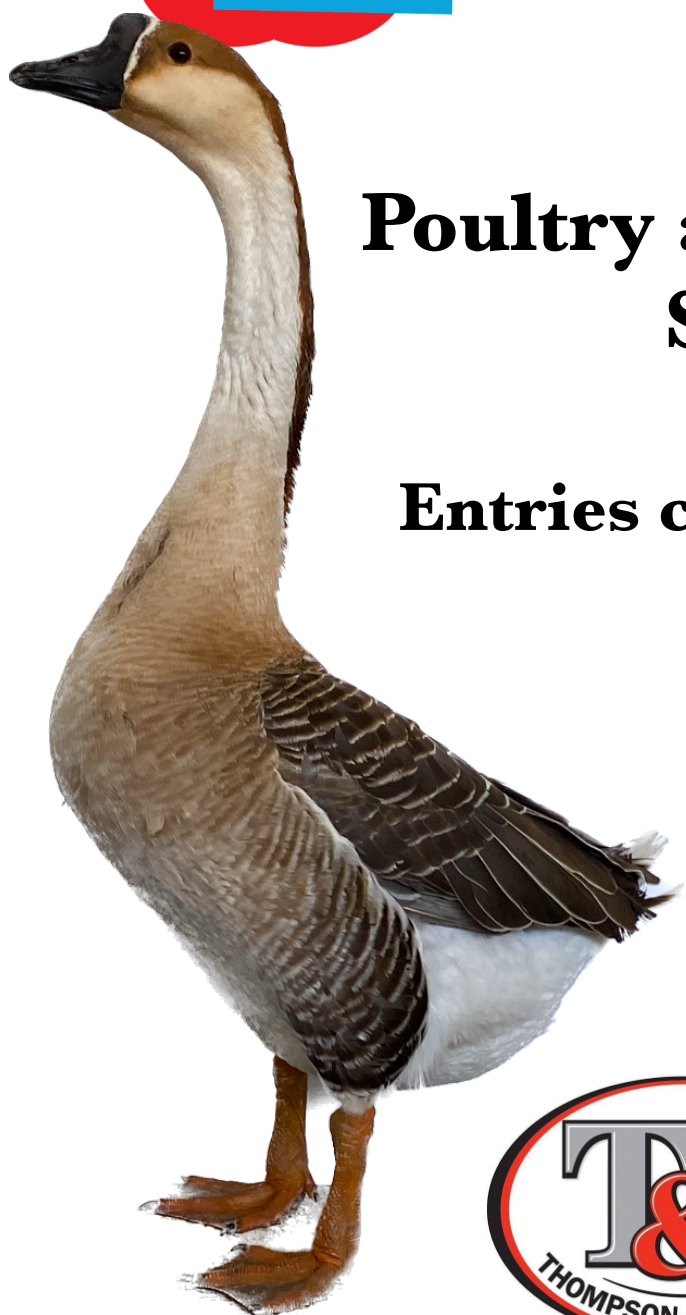

PROGRAM

General Regulations

1. Infested and diseased are not permitted to attend the show and will be removed from the pavilion if entered.
2. Judging shall be by the Australian Poultry Standards second edition and the addendum. The British Poultry Standards will be used if/where appropriate. Judges will be advised of the judging standard prior to the judging on the day of the Show.
3. All livestock must be the property of the exhibitor at least one month before the date of the show.
4. Exhibitors may be required to make a statutory declaration regarding the accuracy of their entry if the committee so desire.
5. If any exhibitor gives a wrong description of his or her exhibit with the intention of deceiving the Alliance, they shall be disqualified from exhibiting at any future show and shall forfeit all fees paid.
6. All eggs are to be cracked and become the property of the Serpentine Jarrahdale Food & Farm Alliance unless arrangements for particular eggs are made with the Chief Steward by the owner prior to judging.
7. Limits on entries may be applied if the pavilion reaches capacity.
8. No exhibit can take more than one first prize in its or any other class.
9. The committee reserves the right of refusing or cancelling any entry without reason for so doing. The decision of the committee on all points shall be final without recourse.
10. Theft of birds or eggs can result in life disqualification from the Alliance.
11. The judges may withhold prizes for such exhibits as they deem unworthy.
12. All poultry exhibits must be on the ground for judging by 8:30am.
13. Exhibits accepted between designated times on entry form. Judging commences at 9.00am SHARP.
14. No appeal against decisions of the judges shall be entertained unless made in writing on the day of the Show and a deposit of \$5.00 made, which will be forfeited if the committee consider the same to be frivolous. Stewards to be made aware of the fact at the time. All appeals to be heard and decided on the day of the Show.
15. Exhibits must not be removed without permission of the stewards.
16. Camping is not allowed on the Show Ground without prior permission.
17. All exhibits must be ready for judging, as their respective classes are called, otherwise they will not be allowed to compete.
18. All entries are received subject to these Show Regulations and By-laws, the special regulation in each section and to the uniform By law made under the Royal Agricultural Society Act, 1926.
19. The Association may refuse any entry without giving any reason therefore.
20. The committee may at any time disqualify from exhibiting either indefinitely or for such a period as they think fit, any exhibitor who has, in the opinion of the committee, been guilty of any breach of these regulations, or whose conduct, whether at or during any show of the Association has in the opinion of the committee been such that they are unfit to exhibit at any event of the Alliance.
21. No person who has been disqualified from exhibiting at any show of the Royal Agricultural Society of Western Australia Incorporated and its affiliated societies, or any show of the Association affiliated therein, shall during the period of disqualification be allowed to act as agent, representative of the exhibitor at any event of the Alliance.
